A human rights matter was settled on March 8, 2018, involving allegations that the Respondent denied housing to a family with a child.

Blair Turner and Blaine Herrmann (the landlords) regret that the family believed they were going to be denied housing because they have a child. They realize that to assume children automatically reduce the quality of living for other tenants is not only false but treats those looking for housing as less deserving, and such actions can lead to homelessness as a result.

“The law is clear – it is discriminatory to refuse housing to tenants based on family status,” said Turner and Herrmann. “We have committed to understanding the obligations under the *Human Rights Code of Ontario*.”
